PEO-SC 2024 was a transformative experience, equipping me with the skills and confidence to pursue opportunities with purpose and resilience.

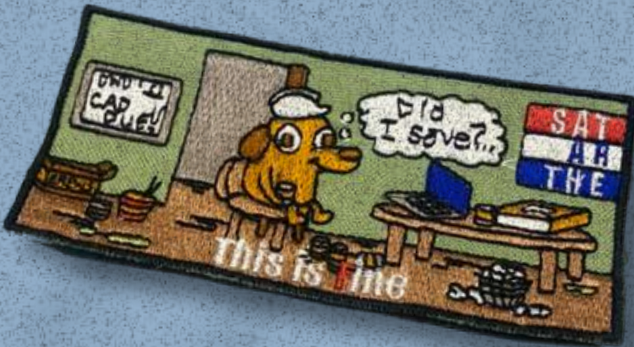
“Crafting Your Career Canvas” inspired us to think creatively about our career prospects...embracing change and learning from failures, reminding us that professional paths are not always straight.

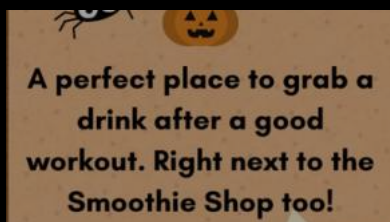
